At time of press, 1436 Dry Branch was under construction and not ready for the photographer to capture all that would be on display with yet another masterpiece by Coleman Log Homes. This handcrafted full log home was originally built as a small weekend get away at the lake. But with permanent residency in mind, the owners wanted the new construction to take on a completely different look that was far from resembling an add-on. This type of request isn't easily accomplished, but the crew at Coleman Log Homes does not readily accept defeat. In order to make good on the the request, additional loads of oversized, handcrafted logs had to be brought in. Within a few days, the heavy workload was laid before them and the new vision would begin. The end result was an additional 4,000 square feet added to the footprint and custom features throughout. This amazing log home overlooks a front row view of beautiful Lake Blue Ridge and is one that you won't want to miss.
